Early Childhood Music Exploration

Our program is designed to introduce young children to the wonderful world of music through fun and engaging activities. We focus on building a solid foundation in basic music theory, developing a sense of rhythm and tempo, and fostering a love for music that is transferable to ALL instruments! Through singing, movement and games, your child will learn:

1. Music Note reading

- Introduction to the musical staff: lines and spaces.
- Identifying and naming notes: A, B, C, D, E, F, G.
- Understanding note values.

2. Solfège

- Introduction to solfège: Do, Re, Mi, Fa, Sol, La, Ti, Do.
- Solfège exercises to develop pitch recognition, tonal identification and vocal accuracy.
- Using solfège in simple songs and melodies.

3. Rhythm and Tempo

- Identifying and creating rhythmic patterns
- Introduction to time signatures: 4/4, 3/4, 2/4.
- Exploring different tempos: slow, medium, fast.
- Practicing keeping a steady beat with a metronome.

4. Identify Basic Musical Terms/Vocabulary

- Introduction to basic musical terms: melody, harmony, rhythm, tempo, dynamics.
- Learning the meaning of dynamic markings.
- Understanding common musical symbols.
